

2011 GREAT RACE



1. All teams will leave from the Key West, Florida. Final destination is the Hawaiian Island of Maui.
2. Each classroom will have a team name. Your team can be divided up by task (i.e. distance group, weather group).
3. Students will be responsible for their itinerary. This includes modes of transportation, lodging and food.
4. The object of the race is to visit all the required sites on the list between Key West, Florida and the Hawaiian Island of Maui in the quickest amount of time spending the least amount of money. You must use at least three forms of transportation and cannot use air travel until you reach the Pacific Coast. Students must have completed all the required activities to win
 - a. Fill out all 8 of the Coinciding Site Sheets
 - b. Landmark Sheet and Weather Sheet
 - c. The Ledger Sheets - All money spent must be logged. Prices must be dated and confirmed. Prices of gas, railroad tickets, boat rentals etc... must be researched on the web and be the actual price. Students must calculate how many gallons of gas they used and how much gas is a gallon when purchased.
 - d. Overall log must be completed
5. Teachers will be responsible for checking log books.

6. Please use transportation page for instructions and rules on transportation

Travel days by car cannot exceed 7 hours in length and you cannot use air travel until you reach the Pacific Coast!!!
